With a strong biosecurity plan, you can protect the health of your farm and maintain productivity even when external threats are present.

- **Identifying Biosecurity Risks**: Learn how to spot potential risks on your farm, from animal interactions to contaminated water sources and equipment, and develop strategies to mitigate these risks.
- **Hygiene and Disease Prevention Practices**: Explore the role of proper hygiene, protective clothing, and vaccinations in reducing the spread of disease.
- **Movement Control and Farm Security**: Gain insights into controlling the movement of people, animals, and equipment on your farm to minimise biosecurity risks.
- **Zoonotic and Communicable Diseases**: Understand zoonotic diseases that transfer from animals to humans, as well as communicable diseases between animals, and how to prevent and manage these threats. Several common diseases are highlighted in the course.
- Notifiable Diseases: Learn about notifiable diseases that require reporting to authorities, how to recognise symptoms, and the immediate actions to take if an outbreak is suspected.

By the end of the course, you will be well-equipped with biosecurity strategies to protect your farm, animals, and yourself from harmful diseases.
